NEW TRAINING PROGRAMS!

DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING SCHOOL (DTS)

Our base launched Poipet's first ever DTS this year. Our 6 students spent 3 months learning about God and what that means for their lives. Then they went on outreach in both Cambodia and Indonesia for over 2 months!

- Over 60 people healed!
- Over 100 new believers in Cambodia and Indonesia!

BIBLE CORE COURSE (BCC)

In addition to the DTS, we have also launched a BCC, which brings our students through the inductive process of studying the Bible. They go through each main type of Scripture and are transformed with a foundational knowledge of the Bible.

- Studied 14 books in depth and read through the entire Bible!

DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING SCHOOL

January 2018 we started our first DTS! This school is focused on influencing all aspects of society, starting with our students. We had six students, all Cambodian from different ways of life: a pastor and his family, two farm boys (who knew close to nothing about Jesus), an ex-monk, and a man fresh out the business world. All of them saw immense breakthrough in different areas of their lives and fresh revelation of Jesus during the lecture phase. After the small revival that happened during the lecture phase, the students were all fired up to go on outreach and share what they learned. As an outreach team, we went to a Cambodian province for one month and then to Indonesia for one month. Upon returning to Poipet, four of our students, volunteered to join in on our Bible Core Course and two of them have now come on as DTS staff for the 2019 year.



BIBLE CORE COURSE

In July we launched the Bible Core Course, which is a first not only for Poipet, but for all of UofN Cambodia. As a community we believe that a solid foundation in and passion for Biblical knowledge is critical to grow a close relationship with Jesus. Upon completing the course, our students were then able to take their knowledge of the Word and share with their families, friends, students and members of our Poipet community. We're excited to continue this school in 2019 with some of our old students returning as staff for the next generation. We're always ready to go deep in God's Word!





YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Our YDC continued strong this year with almost 30 volunteer teachers throughout the year and 80 students as a daily average. Not only were countless lessons planned and phrases learned but friendships were made, food was shared together and people got to hear about the good news of Jesus in and out of their classroom- some students would even join us for weekday morning worship when they didn't have school. God is really reaching out to the community through the hearts of our students!
